The Cascade Locks Resort and Casino project would improve the economic condition of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon (Tribe) by allowing the Tribe to develop a gaming facility at a new location. The proposed project requires a fee-to-trust transfer and review by the Secretary of the Interior to meet the requirements of the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act (IGRA). This EIS has been prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and applicable NEPA regulations, and provides analyses to inform the Secretary on whether the proposed project would be in the best interest of the Tribe and its members and would not be detrimental to the surrounding community, per the IGRA. The proposed project and two alternatives are evaluated in this EIS, along with the No Action Alternative.
